Lake Village billing procedure is as follows. Weather permitting, meters are read the first week of the month, billed by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, and payments are due the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month, giving the member at least a month to pay the bill. In order to reduce costs, bills are not sent. It is member's responsibility to call or stop in at the office to find out what is owed. Two months of nonpayment may result in removal of electric privileges including and up to electric meter being pulled until payment is made. There will be a \$50.00 reconnect fee if meter is pulled. If any past electric is owed and the member comes in to make a dues payment that payment will be applied to the outstanding electric balance first. Any remaining balance will then be applied to the dues. This will not apply for current electric bill.
