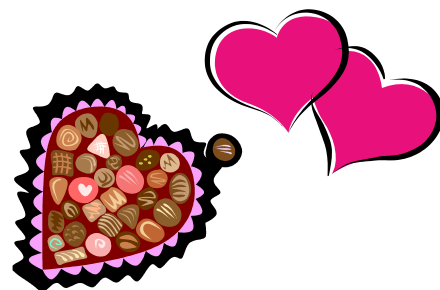

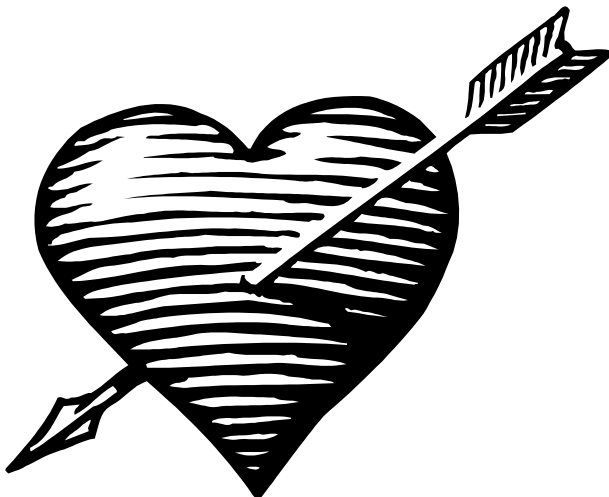
George Ester (Security): Make sure your guests have passes to get in. Reminder, the security cameras are working & the speed limit must in followed.
