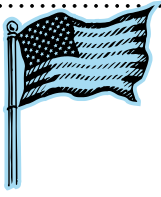

The Seniors Club will continue to provide cake and ice cream once a month to celebrate birthdays. Open to all members and their guests.

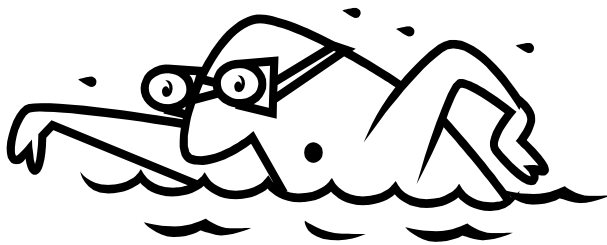

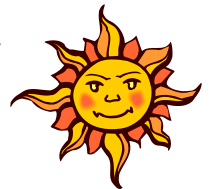

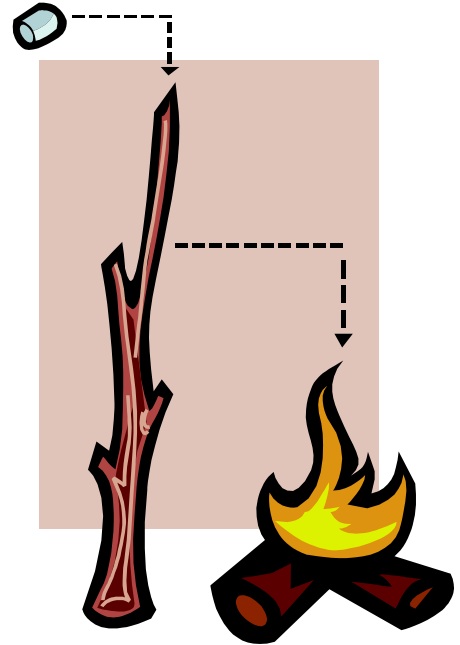
