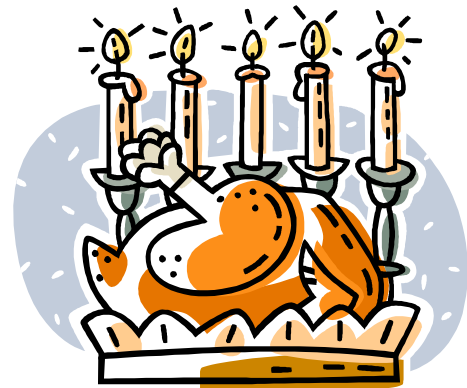

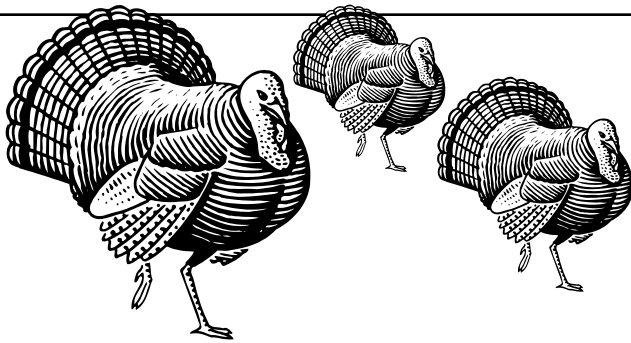
Barry Kern (Sales):

LEAF PICK-UP

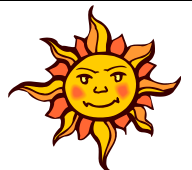
LV will collect & dispose of leaves if they're in the appropriate Biodegradable Lawn and Leaf Paper Bags, and:
