Before we get to the Emergency Protocol – COVID-19, the Directors’ of Lake Village Campground urge all owners, visitors and renters to take due diligence to protect themselves from the Coronavirus (COVID-19) by following all Federal and State recommendations and/or orders. We care about your safety, our safety and the safety of all our citizens who are going through some tough times. Lake Village is a luxury that we all love and cherish and at this time we really need to focus on each other.

The situation changes daily as to the number of cases; but we do know that at some point in the future, whether it be weeks or months, the strong American People will come out of this with unity.

As such, Lake Village still needs your financial support to ensure that our camp can continue after this crisis is over. Those steps are listed below under item 2 (for hardships) so that you don’t lose your status because of unemployment or medical situations. We owe it to our “camp family” to work with you. And a stimulus package to help the “average citizen” may be in the works from the Federal Government to infuse cash to each of you. Cash that you may need for your immediate requirements.

Lake Village is looking at this as a long term commitment to stay solvent until we can congregate again in groups; hug; share a campfire or drink; ride in our golf carts and waive; lend a helping hand; have activities; and just be a part of a family that we all enjoy and covet.

Therefore, this is our Emergency Protocol. We love every one of you and your family and hopefully God will bless this nation, because we have the finest citizens in the world and of course the best Country.

State of Ohio and United States of America Declarations**

Ohio Governor Mike DeWine, declared a “State of Emergency” because of the COVID-19 pandemic. As such, all of the 88 counties in the State of Ohio are covered under this emergency declaration. In addition, President Donald J. Trump declared a “State of Emergency” in the United States that will provide necessary funding under the Robert T. Stafford Act of 1984, as amended; thereby providing funds to State and Local governments through various Federal Agencies. In addition, the Congress has enacted pieces of legislation that will address the needs at the State and local level.

The Directors’ at Lake Village Campground understand that although there is an emergency situation, the needs of our members and their families need to be maintained; but the protection of our volunteers, officials and contractors are of utmost importance to the continuation of duties and services at Lake Village Campground during these trying times, therefore, the following actions will take place:

Office Staff, Sales, Members who utilize the Clubhouse, Renter row and Cabins

- 1. For the protection of our members and staff Lake Village is suspending any past agreements or future agreements for the use of the rental cabins and lots on renter’s row. This is a fluid situation and will updated as needed.**

2. **If you are currently sick, have a respiratory illness, fever of more than 100.4 degrees, have underlying health related issues and any other symptoms associated with either the flu or COVID-19 you should stay at home or your camp and not visit the Clubhouse until these conditions have ended for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing or symptom-altering medicines. Basically, follow the directions of both the State and Federal Government. If business is urgent the office will work with you so that you are not in jeopardy of losing your “Member in Good Standing” status. The number is 440-293-8434.**
3. **The main door to the Clubhouse will be locked and visitors are required to first go to the restroom via the pool entry door and utilize the hand wash and/or sanitizer for a period of at least twenty (20) seconds. When the office is open, Theresa or other office staff will make transactions at the closed gate. No members will be allowed to enter the meeting room. It is recommended that you utilize the same sanitation protocols prior to leaving the facilities. The office will determine those types of transactions (via cash, debit card, check or credit card) that can be accommodated. The office will also provide you with that mail that has been acquired since your last visit. Gate cards, blue tank dumping, propane and other necessities including store inventory can be done at that time.**
4. **Volunteers, office staff and contractors should utilize hand protection (plastic or vinyl gloves) upon arrival at the Clubhouse to protect themselves from potentially contaminated mail, cash or transactions.**
5. **Disinfectant wipes should be used to wipe down the computer keyboard and other devices utilized as part of our duties.**
6. **At present, the Governor of the State of Ohio has required that gatherings of over twenty (20) people be discontinued. And the President has recommended no more than ten (10) people. This is a fluid situation and only through news accounts and officials’ declarations will you know the current restrictions. We urge you to keep up on this information. Although this does not impact Lake Village at this time at your camp site, it does impact our Clubhouse, activities and Party Center. When camp opens for the summer season on April 15, 2020, we will know whether or not this protocol will remain in effect or be suspended. If the situation worsens it may be necessary to cancel some activities of Lake Village and perhaps the Pool based on those recommendations and/or orders by the Ohio Department of Health Department or the Governor of the State of Ohio. Lake Village will take no arbitrary actions, but will be bound by the laws, guidance or orders of the Governor of the State of Ohio and/or the President of the United States and their duly authorized representatives.**
